

How do we know ?

Numerous studies and laboratory analyzes indicate that eggs from cage system are of lower quality compared to non - cage.

The reason for this is the way that animals are capted, treated and fed.

You should keep in mind that in one cage, whose size is aproximatelly the size of this spread flayer, lives up to seven laying hens.

How to make right choice ?

Follow markings on chicken eggs:

- 0 - Organic system
- 1 - Free Range system
- 2 - Cage Free system
- 3 - Cage system

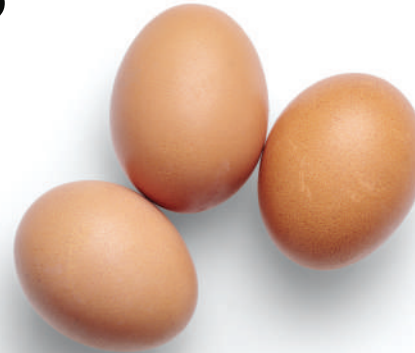
WHAT A LAYING HEN SHOULD LOOK LIKE

Which chicken egg would you rather eat ?



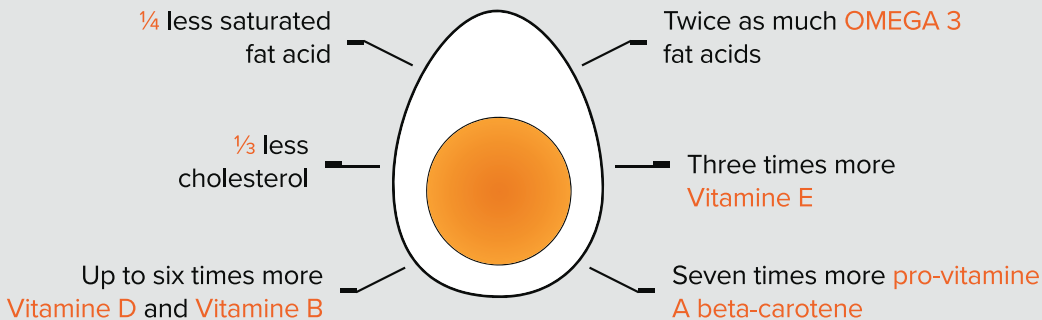
WHAT A LAYING HEN USUALLY LOOKS LIKE

Life of this hen means:

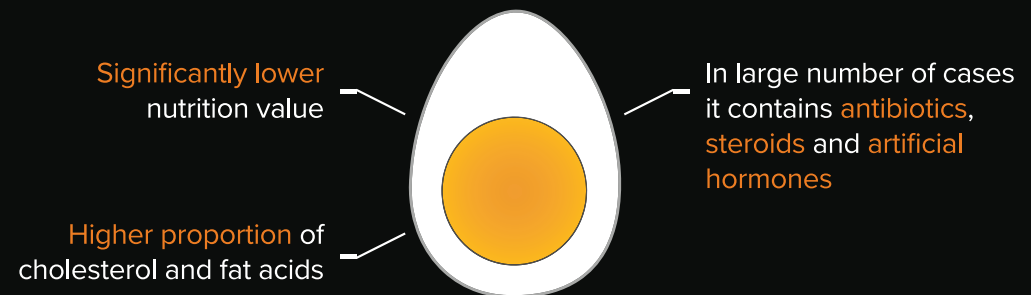
- ♦ Inability to move
